Breeding Shed Requirements

*Please note that we do not require breeding shed forms, but we do ask that you follow the requirements below and please submit a mare nomination form prior to arrival.

- ✓ All Mares must have a current Mare Nomination Sheet on file with the office before the mare will be booked.
- ✓ All Mares must have proper identification when being presented for breeding (halter or neck strap with name). Without proper identification and paperwork, the mare will not be bred.
- ✓ All Mares must be vaccinated for Equine Herpes Virus Type-1 (i.e. Rhinomune, Pneumabort-K, etc.) from 7-90 days before breeding. A statement from your veterinarian must accompany the mare to the breeding shed.
- ✓ Domestic Foaling Mares require no additional tests for first cover.
- ✓ Barren and Mares Not Bred Last Year must provide a negative aerobic (regular) uterine culture dated within 30 days prior to cover.
- ✓ Maiden Mares must provide a negative aerobic (regular) uterine culture dated within 30 days prior to cover; and must be jumped before coming to the breeding shed.
- ✓ All Returning Mares for a third breeding (exclusive of doubles) will be required to provide a negative uterine culture taken after the second breeding.
- ✓ Imported Foaling and Barren Mares please contact the State Veterinarian's Office in Indianapolis, Indiana regarding the proper procedures and acquisition of the Quarantine Releases for the current breeding season. A copy of the Release must accompany the mare on her first trip to the breeding shed.
- ✓ Imported Maiden Mares must comply with the current USDA and Indiana Department of Agriculture regulations; and must be jumped before coming to the breeding shed.
- ✓ Please note that all Mares coming to the breeding shed must be vaccinated for Equine Herpes Virus Type- 1 (ie. Rhinomune, Pneumabort-K, etc.) from 7-90 days before breeding. A statement from your veterinarian to this effect must be furnished by the farm and accompany the mare to the breeding shed.
